

#### **Additional Notes**

12 credits of either Ancient Greek or Latin are co-requisite of the major. These credits must be taken in one language. Students completing LAT 107, Intensive Latin, do not need to take LAT 101 or LAT 102. CLA 101, 201, and 203 do not count toward the Classical Archaeology major.

Majors must take at least twenty-four credits in Classical Archaeology. 12 of these credits must be CLA 204, 220, 221, 222. Students may elect any of the following courses to fill the rest: CLA 225, 227, 322, 323, 329, and 330; ANTHC 126, 127, 226, 227, 228, 231, 232, and 246.

Students who wish to graduate with honors in the major must take CLA 491.
