

## Graduate Student International Travel Guidelines

### Travel Advisory Levels

Graduate students may travel to **Level 1 and Level 2 countries** (as designated by [U.S. State Department Travel Advisory Levels](#) and CDC Health Notices) without any additional steps.

- Travel to a **Level 3 country** requires submission of a **Travel Warning Waiver Petition**.
- Travel to a **Level 4 country** (“Do Not Travel”) also requires a **Travel Warning Waiver Petition** and formal approval.

### Registration Requirements

All graduate students must register **non-coursework international travel** through the [CUNY-GO portal](#).

### Coursework-Based Study Abroad

Graduate students participating in a coursework-based study abroad program must visit the [Education Abroad Office](#) (as undergraduates do) to submit a study abroad application.

### Conference & Non-Coursework Travel

Students traveling abroad for conferences or other non-coursework activities are encouraged to:

- Contact the [Education Abroad Office](#) for pre-departure guidance
- Enroll in international health and safety insurance
