

- Completion of 60 credits at time of admission to the program (up to two courses may be in progress at time of application).
- A combined minimum GPA of 3.0 or higher from all colleges attended.
- Completion of the following prerequisite courses with a grade of "C" or better.
 - English Composition (ENG 12000 or equivalent), 3 cr
 - Intro to Sociology (SOC 10100 or equivalent), 3 cr
 - Introductory Psychology OR Anthropology (PSYCH 10000, PSYCH 15000, ANTHC 10100, or equivalent) 3 cr
 - Introductory level Statistics (e.g., STAT 11000, 11300 or 21300; PSYCH 24800, SOC 24100, ECON 22100 or equivalent) 3 cr
 - Any 4-credit Lab Science course
