Satellite Accumulation Area (SAA) Checklist

- 1. Are all containers spaced so they can be inspected?**
- 2. Is the SAA free of garbage?**
- 3. Are all incompatible wastes segregated properly, ex. acids and bases?**
- 4. Is each container marked with all of the following?**
 - a. The words “Hazardous Waste”**
 - b. The chemical name (ex. Methanol, Hydrochloric Acid) no abbreviations (ex. MEOH, HCL)**
 - c. The hazard associated with those chemicals (ex. ignitable, toxic)**
- 5. Are secondary containment trays used to hold all liquid waste?**
- 6. Is the surface underlying the containers impervious to leaks?**
- 7. Are all containers compatible with the waste inside?**
- 8. Are all containers closed (caps tightened) during storage?**
- 9. Is each container handled to prevent rupture and/or leakage?**
- 10. Is a SAA sign and checklist posted at the SAA?**
