Additional Notes

Students who do not place into STAT 213 will begin with MATH 101 Algebra or MATH 12550 Pre-calculus: The sequence is as follows – MATH 101 or MATH 101EN. [If you make a C you also take MATH 10150] – MATH 12550 [If you make a C, you must take MATH 140] or MATH 124 and MATH 140 or MATH 125 and MATH 140 – STAT 213. If you begin with MATH 101, the Degree Map is shifted by two semesters and still allow for completion of the degree in 4 years; in this case, the MATH or STAT elective will be taken in the last semester.

- **STAT 212 and 214 could be taken either Fall or Spring and in any order or at the same time
- At Math 260, students who do well should consider our BA/MA program. See the Statistics advisor.
- Required STAT or MATH elective must be approved by Statistics advisor
- Please see Statistics advisor for Actuarial sequence
- STAT 311 is taught Fall and Spring but STAT 312 and 313 are Spring and Summer only.
