Test Out Policy

The Department of Computer Science offers exceptionally well-prepared students the opportunity to receive credit by examination for CSCI 127 (*Introduction to Computer Science*); CSCI 135 (*Analysis & Design 1/C++ Programming*) and CSCI 150 (*Discrete Structures*). Several points must be made clear:

- 1. The student must achieve a grade of 80 (B) or better in order to receive credit for the exam.
- 2. The student will pay no fee for the course, and will receive no grade; only "Credit by Exam" will be noted on the transcript. By college policy, it is not possible to receive a letter grade for such an exam.
- The exam will be scheduled at the convenience of the student and the Department, and Two hours are allowed for the 135 and 150 tests; three hours for the 127 exam. Guidelines for each exam are available in the Computer Science Department office.
- 4. The exam will cover the entire semester's syllabus.
- 5. No student may take the exam if they have taken the course here at Hunter and failed it.
- 6. No student may take such an exam more than once for any course.
