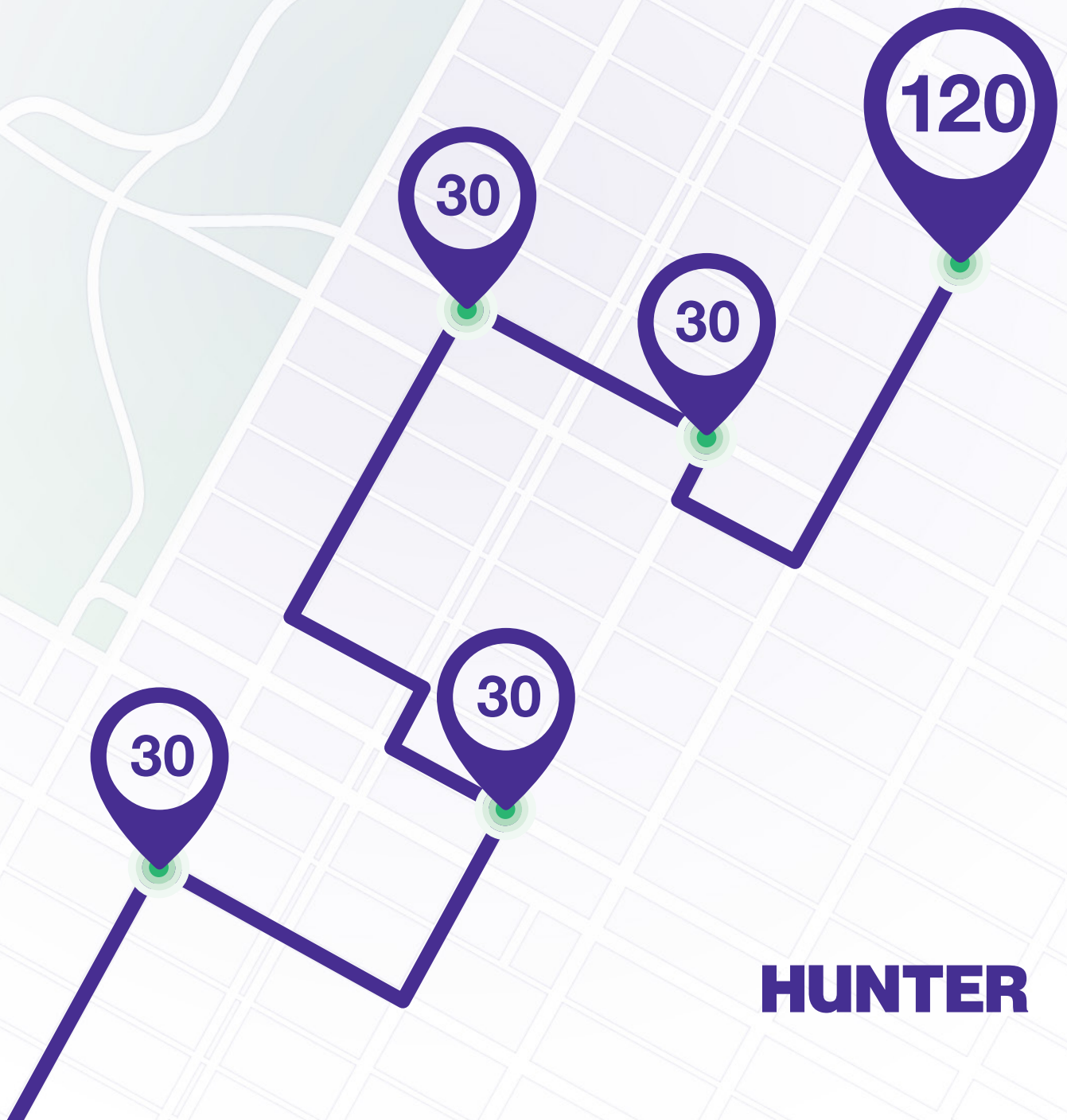

Required Crew Assignments (RCA)

Theatre majors must complete two non-credited crew assignments in support of departmental production activity. An RCA is comparable to a three-credit class (between 40-90 hours per RCA). You will be trained and supervised by our departmental faculty and staff in production areas such as Scene Shop, Costume Shop, Electrics, Stage Management, Running Crew, Board Operation, and Ushering.
